

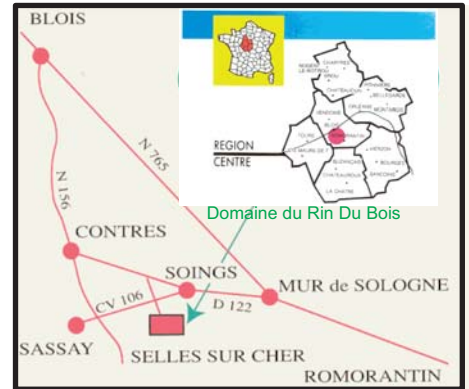


Domaine du Rin Du Bois



Presentation

The Rin du Bois Domain, 20 ha in size, is situated on the south of Blois in Loir and Cher, and home to the famous Loire Chateaux. The Domain was born in 1969, after a replant of the vines done 8 to 10 years before. For a few years, we have practiced a reasoned culture in our vineyards, with the goal to respect the environment. We produce many wines, which in general are ruled by lightness, finesse and aromatic richness. They express with their robe and their bouquet, all the charm of the terroir.



The wines

- * **Touraine Sauvignon White** : Sureau and blackcurrant buds aromas. Nice balance in mouth with a citrusy finish, that lasts after tasting.
- * **Touraine Rosé**: Salmon colour. Light wine, and remarkably fruity.
- * **Touraine Gamay Red** : Bright red colour. Rich in wine aromas. Very fruity and easy to drink.
- * **Touraine Les Charmilles Red** : Powerful and harmonious wine. Long and complex aromas.
- * **Touraine Authentica Red** : Full-bodied wine with liquored cherry flavours.
- * **Touraine Noble Terre Red** : Very strong grape savour, with fine flavours: Floral and fruity.
- * **Touraine Cuvée Antoine Red** : Rich in aromas, very fruity, with a supple and full-bodied structure.
- * **Touraine Les Boissettes Red** : Fruit, structure and character (cot), tannins, long and complex aromas (cabernet franc), fresh (gamay).
- * **Touraine Cuvée A l'ancienne Red** : Richly fruity nice firm but fine tannins present. powerful and very rich.
- * **Methode Traditionnelle White** : Fine bubbles, fine bouquet, fruity wine, light.

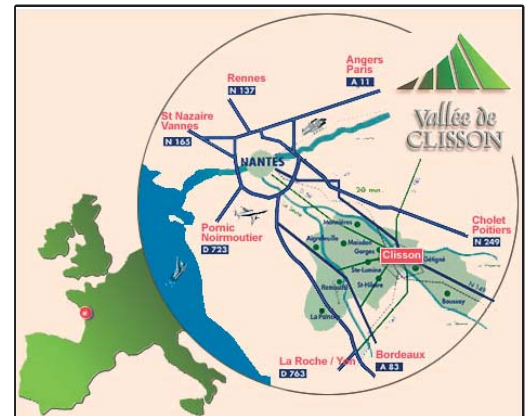
Domaine des Cognettes



Presentation

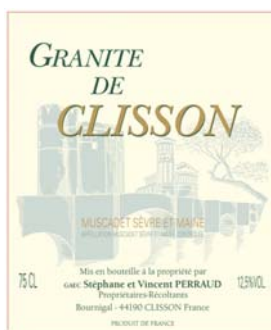
The Domain des Cognettes is situated on the village CLISSON.

The experience is winemaking has been given by our parents and our grandfather. Our vineyard is planted on granite soil and sandy/clay . The Melon, grape variety of the AOC Muscadet Sèvre et Maine and of Cru Granite de Clisson, represent 22 ha out of the 32 ha of our domain. Every parcel will have its wine. The wine, a result of a years work, is the obtaining and the value added of the harvested grape trying to get the best from a terroir, a grape variety, our savoir-faire (art). Harvest is exclusively done by hand.



The wines

- * **Musc. Sevre & Maine Sur Lie White** : Nose with good intensity and great freshness. Floral note and citrus fruits. Lemon vivacity and a flavour light mineral.
- * **Granite de Clisson White**: Intense nose and complex. Fragrance of acacia flower, dry fruits and exotic fruits. Ample mouth and generous.
- * **Gros Plant White**: This wine develops subtle aromas of green lemon and white flowers. Fresh and lively in attack. Its mouth, in exotic nuances, ends on the mineral.
- * **Methode Tradit.** : Delicate bubbles, fragrance of fruits at white pulp. The mouth is very palatable by complicity of our three grapes varieties
- * **Muscadet White** : Fresh nose and young. Various fragrance of flower note, and white pulp fruits. In mouth, freshness and flavour lightness mineral..

Mas de Bagnols



Presentation

6 hectares (15 acre) family run estate in the village of Vinezac in the south of France. Reasoned growing: control of output, cover planting, rigorous pruning... Rocky hillside vineyards. Noble grape varieties: syrah, grenache, merlot, cabernet sauvignon, chardonnay.



The wines

- * Cotes du Vivarais Red Cuvée Pauline : red berries, vanilla, sweet spices, slightly woody.
- * Cotes du Vivarais Rosé : very fruity (cherry, raspberry, strawberry) underscored by notes of anise. Supple yet fresh.
- * Cotes du Vivarais Red : Notes of vanilla, sweet spices, thyme, pepper, slightly woody.
- * VDP des Coteaux de L'Ardeche Cuvée Marjorie Red : Ripe red berries, plum jam, finale of fruits in alcohol, underscored by notes of liquorice and spices.
- * VDP des Coteaux de L'Ardeche White : floral nose, volume in mouth, buttery and vanilla finish.

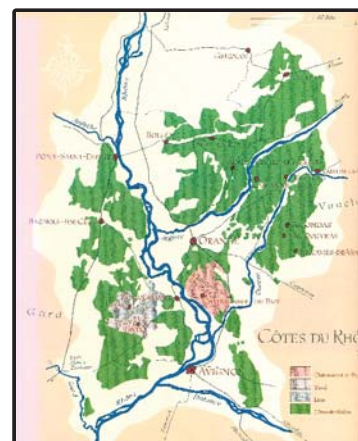

Presentation

The Domain de la Graveirette is in Sarrians, in Provence. The horizon is composed of Mont Ventoux, the Dentelles de Montmirail to the east, and the sloapes of Chateauneuf du Pape to the west. It produces wines under the appellation Chateauneuf du Pape and Cotes du Rhone, but also good quality "vins de Pays". The vinification of the parcels began in 2005, with 10 ha of production. The main concern of the domain rests in expressing to the maximum possible the "terroir" depending on the grape variety which is associated with it.



The wines

- * **Côtes du Rhône Rosé** : Fresh in the mouth with agruma aromas and candy fruits. Long and refreshing persistence.
- * **Côtes du Rhône Red** : Dark cherry robe. Copious fruit. Nice concentration - blueberry, redcurrant, fleshy and suave tannins heading toward toasty finish.
- * **Chateauneuf Du Pape Red** : Purple robe, it smells black grape, spicy with a light grilled touch. Very well structured and concentrated. Taste of black grape and a liquorice touch.
- * **VDP de la p. d'Orange red** : Cherry robe. Wine of pleasure with fresh red fruits, blueberries, redcurrant and soft tannins. The finish reveals more grilled aromas
- * **VDP de la p. d'Orange Merlot Red**: Nose intense and powerful, . Concentrated and fleshy tannins reveal an impression of sweetness which lingers with spicy notes, more toffee.
- * **VDP de la p. d'Orange Rosé** : Intense pink robe. Fruity nose, cherry and strawberry. Ample mouth and well balanced with a nice finish.
- * **VDP de Vaucluse White** Well balanced, white fruits notes, a final freshness giving a pleasant sensation.
- * **VDP de Vaucluse Red** : Purple robe. Wild fruit aromas, forest with a freshness in mouth. Solid tannins and toasty notes in finish.
