

Rabbit? **Japanese inspiration**

What you need:

- Hook n°3 (for European) or D (for US)
- Adapted yarn with 2 colors (you can choose acrylic, mohair, 100% wool)
- Poly-fil to stuff
- Some embroidery floss
- Some blusher

Crochet techniques: single crochet (sc), increasing (inc.) and decreasing (dec.)

For the head:

Row 1:6

Row 2:12 (increase in each stich)

Row 3: 18 (inc. 1 st. on 2)

Row 4: 24 (inc. 1 st on 3)

Row 5: 30 (inc. 1 st. on 4 and change color of yarn)

Row 6: 36 (inc. 1 st on 5)

Row 7 to row 9: 42 (inc. 1 st. on 6)

Row 10: 36 (decrease 1 st. on 6)

Row 11: 30 (dec. 1 st. on 5)

Row 12: 24 (dec. 1 st. on 4)

Row 13: 18 (dec. 1 st. on 3)

Row 14:12 (dec. 1 st on 2)

Row 15:6

For the body:

Row 1:6

Row 2:12

Row 3:18

Row 4:24

Row 5 and 6:30

Row 7 to row 10:24

Row 11 to row 17:18

For the ears:

Row 1:6

Row 2:12

For the arms:

Row 1 and 2:6

Change color.

Row 3 to row 6:6

To join:

Cut yarn and insert threads.

Stuff only head and body.

Then sew each element:

Head to body

Hears to head

Arms to body

Embroider eyes and a mouth.

Make cheeks with blusher.
