Baby Blanket Almeria



Material:

5 balls of Mérina Cheval Blanc color Brun,

Needles 8mm, 2 stitch markers.

Gauge (Andalusian double stitch):13 stitches/12 rows

Size of the blanket:50cm/80cm.

Points:

Garter Stitch: knit every stitches of every rows.

Andalusian double stitch:

Row 1 and 3 (right side row): knit.

Row 2: purl.

Row 4 (wrong side row): purl 1, *knit 2, purl 1*, repeat from *to*.

Work:

Cast on 56 stitches with double threads, do 6 rows of garter stitch, with a selvedge stitch at the beginning of each row.

Then: 1 selvedge stitch, 4 stitches in garter stitch, 1 stitch marker, knit in Andalusian double stitch, 5 stitches before the end of the row, put a stitch marker, and knit the five last stitches of the row in garter stitch.

Continue so until the desired height, finish by 6 rows of garter stitch, and bind off rather flexibly on the right side of the work.

Bring in the threads, wash the blanket, shape it by blocking it slightly, cut the threads to short, offer it!
