## Shawl Fleur

## Material:

Semilla Gots BC Garn 2 colors: color A 2 balls and color B 3 balls.

Circular needles $3,5 \mathrm{~mm}$ and 4 mm . Cable needle, yarn needle, blocking material, scissors.


Points and abbreviations:
A : knit in color A.
$B$ : knit in color $B$.
st : stitch.
k: knit.
kA : knit in color A.
$k B$ : knit in color $B$.
p: purl.
pA : purl in color $A$.
PB : purl in color $B$.
m1: make 1.
mIA: make 1 in color $A$.
$m$ IB : make 1 in color $B$.
sl : slip stitch. On the right side rows, put your yarn behind the work (like knitting a knit stitch) and slip the stitch from the left needle to the right needle without knitting it. On the wrong side rows, put the yarn in front of the work (as if to knit a purl stitch) and slip the stitch from the left needle to the right needle without knitting it.

Yo : Yarn over.
D3 : Decrease centered: insert the second stitch on the left needle by passing your needle in front of the work in the middle of the stitch and following, pass the first stitch from the left needle to the right without knitting it. Put this first stitch back on the left needle and knit the two stitches on the left needle together. Then bind off the stitch that was sewn previously over the one just knitted.

(...)x... : work the pattern in parentheses as many times as indicated after the " $x$ ". [...]x.... :work the pattern in brackets as many times as indicated after the "x".

## Cables:

T1: on 4 stitches, put 2 stitches on the cable needle placed behind the work, knit the next 2 stitches in the color in which they appear. Take the 2 stitches from the cable needle and knit them in the color in which they appear.
$T 2$ :on 4 stitches, put 2 stitches on the cable needle placed in front of the work, knit the next 2 stitches in the color in which they appear. Take the 2 stitches from the cable needle and knit them in the color in which they appear.

Gauge: stockinette st needles $3,5 \mathrm{~mm}, 10 / 10 \mathrm{~cm}: 22$ stitches $/ 33$ rows.

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## Work:

## First part in slipped stitches:

The rows will alternate colors A and B with slipped stitches in color B. At the beginning of each row, the number of this row, the color in which it is knitted and the fact that it is knit or purl are indicated.
The final number of stitches is indicated at the end of each row in parentheses.
With 3.5 mm needles, cast on 48 stitches in color A and make 2 rows by knitting all the stitches.

## Part two: two-tone intarsia and cables.

For this portion, the rows are knitted in jacquard in the 2 colors. The cables are also two-tone. Remember: Knit the stitches in the color they come in. The colors are stipulated after each stitch. Be flexible in your knitting to obtain a uniform effect on the knitting, and remember to cross your threads at the beginning and end of the row. Switch to 4 mm needles and continue.

R3: k2, Yo, k4, Y0, k1, (Y0, k6, D3, k6, Y0, k1) x25, Yo, k4, Yo, k2.(417st)
R5: k2, Yo, k6, Yo, k1, (Y0, k6, D3, k6, Yo, k1)x25, Yo, k6, Yo, k2.(421st)
R7: k2, Yo, k8, Yo, k1, (Yo, k6, D3, k6, Yo, k1)x25, Yo, k8, Yo, k2.(425st)
R9: k2, Yo, k10, Yo, k1, (Y0, k6, D3, k6, Yo, k1)x25, Yo, k10, Yo, k2.(427st)

Take color A and make a row identical to row 21. Then for the next row, still in color A, knit all the stitches.
Then, on the right side row, bind off all the stitches very loosely with color A by purling all the stitches.Block the shawl in the shape of a half circle and using the points that the knitting has formed naturally. Bring in all the threads and cut them short.
