

Gemma Collar

One size

Material:

2 balls of [Saphir](#),
[Cheval Blanc](#), here
color Taupe.

Circular needles
6mm,

1 stitch marker.



Abbreviations:

st: stitch

k: knit

p: purl

Yo: Yarn Over

SK2P: slip 1, knit 2 together, pass slip stitch over K2tog

...: repeat from*to* till the end of the row/round.

Gauge(stocking stitch, needles 6mm): 15st/23rs.

Work:

Cast on 72 st, put the stitch marker and form the round in knitting in ribs 1/1 :

Round to be reproduced: *1md, 1mv*

Knit in ribs 1/1 up to 10 cms high then pass in fancy ribs:

Round 1 : *k1, Yo, SK2P, Yo, k4*

Round 2 : knit.

Repeat these 2 rounds up to total 20 cms in height.

Then begin the increases:

Round1 : *k2, Yo, k1, Yo, k5* (88 st)

Round 2 and all the odd rounds : Knit

Round 3 : *k3, Yo, k1, Yo, k6* (108 st)

Round 5 : *k4, Yo, k1, Yo, k7* (126 st)

Round 7 : *k5, Yo, k1, Yo, k8* (144 st)

Round 8 : *k6, Yo, k1, Yo, k9* (162 st)

Round 9 : *k7, Yo, k1, Yo, k10* (180 st)

Round 11 : *k8, Yo, k1, Yo, k11* (198 st)

Round 13 : *k9, Yo, k1, Yo, k12* (216 st)

Knit the round 14 and bind off at the round 15.

Note: you can enlarge this collar in version "capelet" by continuing the increases on the same rhythm.

Then, form the top of the collar as a turtleneck, and make a very discreet sewing to maintain the bottom of ribs 1/1 welded at the bottom of the fancy ribs, in this way the top of the collar will stay firmly in place. Bring in the threads and cut them short.
