

Criollo Scarf

Material:

Needles 4.5mm,

1 ball of de [XL Kleckse Zartbitter](#) for a small scarf, 2 for a bigger one.

Work :

Cast on 82 stitches and do 4 rows of garter stitch.

For the pattern

Row 1 (right side): 1 selvedge stitche, Knit 4, *[Knit 2 together] 3 times, [Knit 1, 1 Yarn Over] 6 times, [Knit 2 together] 3 times*, repeat from *to*, and finish with Knit 5.

Row 2 (wrong side): 1 selvedge stitche, knit.

Row 3 (right side): 1 selvedge stitche, knit.

Rang 4 (wrong side): 1 selvedge stitche, purl.

Principle of this scarf: you can do several consecutive **patterns** (always 4 rows), then insert rows of stocking stitch. What gives free rein to your envy for moment, if you work the indicated wool or the other one with gradations of color, you can so ally the openwork motives to a color put in more forward in the rows of stocking stitch.

You can also repeat the **pattern** on the entire scarf for a very openwork and very regular effect.

To finish the scarf: make a last **pattern**, 4 rows of garter stitch and bind off flexibly. Fasten off, take time to block well. Cut the thread to short.
