Education, the future of Europe? Europe, the future of education?

European Seminar, AEDE-France

Paris, 20-21 November 2010

«*Europe will not be made all at once, or according to a single plan. It will be built through concrete achievements which first create a de facto solidarity*» (Declaration by Robert Schuman, 9 May, 1950)

60 years later, we are fully aware that we need Europe and that Europe needs our concrete achievements. That is why the Association Européenne De l'Éducation-France (French section of the European Association of Teachers) will organize a Seminar in November 2010, to try and assess, together with our European colleagues, our “*concrete achievements*” in the area of European education.

Based on analyses of experiments, evaluation reports, theoretical research, the following questions will be addressed:

Part 1: Education, the future of Europe?

1. How can formal education contribute to the development of European citizenship literacy? What would that imply for Teacher Training Institutions?
2. What bridges connect the inhabitants of the European area (territories, history, values, languages, shared experiences, etc.)?
3. What place does mobility within the European Union occupy in the development of the European citizen?

Part 2: Europe, the future of education?

4. How can comparative studies at European level and the recommendations of the European Union stimulate new dynamism and innovation in the training of European teachers and other educational staff, as well as in pedagogical approaches?
