

# Hat and scarf Adamante

Size Medium and large



## Material :

6 balls of [Saphir Cheval Blanc](#).

Circular needles 6mm and cable 60cm, needles 12mm,

A stitch marker, a row counter, a wool needle.

## Abbreviations and points :

k : knit

p : purl

SKP : Slip, knit, pass over

K2tog : knit 2 stitches together

P2tog : purl 2 stitches together.

ss : selvedge stitch : at the beginning of the row, slip the stitch, at the end of the row, knit the stitch.

\*...\* : repeat what is between \* as many time as necessary.

### *Stocking Stitch with straight needles:*

Right side row : knit

Wrong side row : purl. Repeat these 2 rows.

### *Stocking Stitch with circular needles:*

Knit every rounds.

### *Ribs 2/2, with circular needles:*

Round : \*k2, p2\*. Repeat this round as much as necessary

### *Purl Stocking Stitch with straight needles:*

Right side row : purl

Wrong side row : knit. Repeat these 2 rows.

## Hat

Large adult size: 58/61cm of hat size.

Medium adult size: 54/57cm of hat size.

Cast on 72, 68 stitches on circular needles 6mm, put the stitch marker and close the ring in magic loop.

knit 10, 9 cm in ribs 2/2.

Then begin this pattern:

Rounds 1 to 4: Stocking Stitch.

Rounds 5 and 9: purl.

Rounds 6 and 8: knit

Round 7: \*1SKP, 1Yo\*.

Repeat these 9 rounds

At 24, 23cm of height (ribs included), decrease:

For decreases (DEC), keep on knitting the pattern and do as follow:

If it's in a round that is knit: do a SKP

If it's in a round that is purl: do a P2tog

Don't do any decrease on the round 7, but the round after.

**For the large size:**

Decrease 1: \*DEC, 7 stitches\* (64 stitches left)

Then do 2 rounds.

Decrease 2: \*DEC, 6 stitches \*(56 stitches left)

Then do 2 rounds.

Decrease 3: \*DEC, 5 stitches \*(48 stitches left)

Then do 2 rounds.

Decrease 4: \*DEC, 4 stitches \*(40 stitches left)

Then do 2 rounds.

At the next round, knit all the stitches 2 together, you will have 20 stitches left. Cut the thread at 30 cm and fix the top of the hat, fasten off.

**For the medium size:**

Decrease 1: \*DEC, 6 stitches \*(56 stitches left)

Then do 1 round.

Decrease 2: \*DEC, 5 stitches \*(48 stitches left)

Then do 2 rounds.

Decrease 3: \*DEC, 4 stitches \* (40 stitches left)

Then do 2 rounds.

At the next round, knit all the stitches 2 together, you will have 20 stitches left. Cut the thread at 30 cm and fix the top of the hat, fasten off.

Then do a very discreet sew: The bottom of the hatis folded up towards the outside and positioned under the first round of the motive, sew in this position so as to create a wide edge of ribs.



## Scarf :

With the straight needles 12mm and the thread in double, cast on 24 stitches.

Every row begin and end with a selvedge stitch

Do 4 rows of "*Purl Stocking Stitch*"

Then knit this motive:

10 rows of stocking stitch.

Rows 11 and 15(right side rows), rows 12, 14, 16(wrong side rows): purl

Row 13: 1ss, (1SKP, 1Yo)x5 , (1K2tog, 1Yo)x6, 1ss.

Repeat these 16 rows, and keep enough wool to do 4 rows of "*Purl Stocking Stitch*", then bind off on the next right side row.

Cut the threads and fasten off.
