# Crochet doll Pirate Jack - pattern



## You will need:

- yarns: white, ecru, blue marine, red, turquoise, orange, black (100% cotton)
- crochet hook size 3.00 mm
- polyester toy stuffing
- black thread
- buttons: red, violet, blue, green,
- red belt (I've used a small dog-collar)
- earring
- -skull

Level: beginner/basic skills of crocheting are needed

Size of the finished toy high: 33 cm

## Abbreviations:

sc - single crochet

st - stitch

ch - chain stitch

dec - sc next 2 stitches together

inc - sc in indicated stitch 2 times

rnd - round

hdc - half double crochet

### Notes:

- 1. The pattern is worked using the amigurumi method of crochet. Work the simple single crochet stitches continuously in a spiral without closing off each round with a slip stitch.
- 2. You may find it helpful to use a stitch marker in the first stitch of each round, moving it up as you work.

#### Start to stuff the head

Continue to stuff the head.

Now break the yarn and make sure you leave enough yarn to sew on later the head to the body.



# Legs (make 2 of them) and Body

### Use a blue marine yarn.

### Make a magic ring

5-6rnd. >> (sc) across (24sc) (2rnds)

7rnd. >> 7sc, 5dec, 7sc (19sc)

8rnd. >> 7sc, 3dec, 5sc, inc (17sc)

### Join a white yarn.

9rnd. >> 7sc, dec, 8sc (16sc)
10rnd. >>(sc) across (16sc)
```

## Join a red yarn.

11-12rnd. >> (sc) across (16sc) (2rnds)

Join a white yarn.

13-14rnd. >> (sc) across (16sc) (2rnds)

Join a red yarn.

15-16rnd. >> (sc) across (16sc) (2rnds)

Join a white yarn.

17-18rnd. >> (sc) across (16sc) (2rnds)

Join a blue marine yarn.

19rnd. » (sc, inc) x8 (24sc) 20-26rnd. » (sc) across (24sc) (7rnds)

Start to stuff the legs

27rnd. » see below

Now break the yarn and work a second leg the same way. When you've finished both legs hold them side by side. Now so together one st of first and second leg at time to connect the both legs. Here is the new beginning of all following rounds. Now work 48sc across both legs. After that you should be right between the legs facing the backside of the body.







28rnd. >> 21sc, (inc, sc) x2, inc,22sc (51sc)

30rnd. >> 22sc, (inc, 2sc) x2, inc, 22sc (54sc)

31rnd. » (sc) across (54sc) 32rnd. » (8sc, inc) x6 (60sc)

33-36rnd » (sc) across (60sc) (4rnds)

### Join an ecru yarn.

37-42rnd » (sc) across (60sc) (6rnds)

## Continue to stuff the body



Join a colour turquoise yarn.

43-44rnd. » (sc) across (60sc) (2rnds)

#### Join a white yarn.

Join a colour turquoise yarn.

Join a white yarn.

49rnd. >> (sc) across (60sc)

50rnd. >> 23sc 9 dec, 19sc (51sc)

Join a colour turquoise yarn.

51rnd. » (sc) across (51sc)

52rnd. >> 20sc, dec, (5sc, dec) x 2, 15sc (48sc)

Join a white yarn.

54rnd.  $\Rightarrow$  (dec, 6sc)  $\times$  6 (42sc)

Join a colour turquoise yarn.

55rnd. » (sc) across (42sc)

56rnd.  $\Rightarrow$  (dec, 5sc)  $\times$  6 (36sc)

Continue to stuff the body

Join a white yarn.

57rnd. » (sc) across (36sc)

58rnd.  $\Rightarrow$  (dec, 4sc)  $\times$  6 (30sc)

#### Join a colour turquoise yarn.

#### Join a white yarn.

#### Join an ecru yarn.

63-64rnd. » (sc) across (18sc)

## Continue to stuff the body







### **Arms** (make 2 of them)

2rnd.  $\Rightarrow$  (inc)  $\times$ 6 (12sc)

» (sc, inc) x6 (18sc) 3rnd. 4-6rnd >> (sc) across (18sc) (3rnds) » (dec, 4sc) x 3 (15sc) 7rnd. 8-10rnd. >> (sc) across (15sc) (3rnds) 11rnd >> dec, 13sc (14sc) 12-14rnd >> (sc) across (14sc) (3rnds) >> dec, 12sc (13sc) 15rnd. >> (sc) across (13sc) (3rnds) 16-18rnd » dec, 11sc (12sc) 19rnd. 20-22rnd >> (sc) across (12sc) (3rnds) 23rnd. » dec, 10sc (11sc)

27rnd. >> dec,9sc (10sc)

28-32rnd >> (sc) across (10sc) (5rnds)

24-26rnd >> (sc) across (11sc) (3rnds)

#### Don't stuff entire arm

Now break the yarn and work the second arm the same way.



# Sleeve (make 2 of them)

#### Join a colour turquoise yarn.

# Pirate band for eye


Use a black yarn.


Leave the beginning of the yarn (approx. 95cm)

Make a magic ring

1rnd. >> 2ch, 5hdc, and make 60ch, then change side and make 60ch.


Note: The clear yarn in the pictures below is used in order to see better every step of making the band.

# 3. Do lines.




















# 4. Embroider hair on the head.
