Marcel

This rather simple model is inspired by a hat that I wore when I was a child, and that I can always wear, it is adaptable, flexible, and to decline in the colors that you like.

A very warm and comfortable hat, which adapts to many heads, big or small!



Hat size M 56/57cm head circumference, suitable for children from 8/10 years. Size L (58cm of head circumference and more).

Material:

2 balls of <u>Edition 3.0 Schoppel Wolle</u> and 2 matching balls of <u>Babyalpaga Kremke</u>, <u>knitting kit</u> <u>available</u> here : <u>https://lesaiguillesdecamille.com/Kit-Marcel-bonnet-double-p-1196-c-96_125.html#fp</u>

Circular needles 3,5mm (or set of 4 needles of the same size),1 stitch marker ,scissors, tape measure and wool needle.

Points and abbreviations:

The colors are indicated at the beginning of the round.

A : color <u>Schoppel Wolle Edition 3.0</u>

B: color Babyalpaka Kremke.

st:stitch k:knit p:purl.

m1: knit 2 stitches in a stitch: first knit the front strand, and without slipping the stitch on the right needle, knit the back strand. Let the two stitches thus formed on the right needle and keep on knitting.

K2tog: knit 2 stitches together.

... knit the pattern between * and * as many times as necessary to go to the end of the round.

R: round.

Ribs 1/1 knit in the round: *k1, p1* for every rounds...

Gauge: ribs 1/1 (without streching them): 32st/34rounds

Work:

The indications for the different sizes are indicated in the pattern in bold type. For both sizes, in color A, cast on 20 stitches in magic loop on the circular needles (or on 4 needles), put the stitch marker and form the circle and start knitting.

A-R3: * m1* (40 sts)

A-R4: *k*

B-R5: *k1, m1* (60sts)

B-R6: *k*

A-R7 and R8: *k*

A-R7 and R8: *k*

B-R10: *k*

B-R11: *k*

B-R12: *k3, m1* (100sts)

A-R13 and 14: *k*

A-R15: *k4, m1* (120sts)

A-R16: *k*

B-R17: *k*

B-R18, for size M knit this round: *k5, m1 * (140 sts)

A-R19,20, 21 and 22: *k1, p1*

B- R23 and 24 : *k1, p1*

Repeat the rows in red until you reach 50 cm total height for both sizes.

<u>Important</u>: When knitting, remember to close the starting circle by threading the inside of the 20 stitches tightly, and bring in the other threads. The hat being completely closed at the end, it would be impossible to do it by finishing the work.

At 50 cm total height, start to decrease:

A-R1: for size L knit this round: * k6, K2tog* (140sts)

A-R1: for size M knit this round: *k5, K2tog * (120sts)

A-R2:*k*

A-R3: for size L knit this round: * k5, K2tog* (120sts)

A-R3: for size M knit this round: *k4, K2tog* (100sts)

B-R4 and 5:*k*

A-R6: for size L knit this round: * k4, K2tog* (100sts)

A-R6: for size M knit this round: *k3, K2tog* (80sts)

A-R7 and 8:*k*

A-R9: for size L knit this round: * k3, K2tog* (80sts)

A-R9: for size M knit this round: *k2, K2tog* (60sts)

B-R10 and 11:*k*

A-R12: for size L knit this round: * k2, K2tog* (60sts)

A-R12: for size M knit this round: *k1, K2tog* (40sts)

A-R13 and 14:*k*

A-R15: for size L knit this round: * k1, K2tog* (40sts)

A-R15: for size M knit this round: *K2tog* (20sts) it's finished for this size, follow the indications bellow to close your hat.

B-R16 and 17: for size L:*k*

A-R18: for size L knit the round :*K2tog* (20sts) it's finished for this size, follow the indications bellow to close your hat.

Cut the thread to 20 cm long, put it on the woolen needle and pass it in the remaining 20 stitches. Remove the circular needle, tighten the stitches, repeat the operation once. Pass the needle in a stitch and make a tight knot, repeat the operation once. Bring the thread into the hat by its top and bring out the needle, taking care to leave the thread in, and it's over!
