Scarf Okaïdo

Material:

2 balls of Noro Taiyo (100g/200m, 40% cotton, 30% silk, 15% wool, 15% nylon).

Needles 6.5mm

Cable Needle

Possibly a meter of row

Twist:

This twist included 4 stitches:

Slide 3 stitches on the cable needle since the left needle.

Place the cable needle behind the work.

Knit the first stitch which appears on the left needle at the place.

Hand on 2 of 3 stitches of the cable needle on the left needle, knit these purl stitches.

Slide the last stitch presents on the cable needle on the left needle and to knit it.

It is the only twist of this model.

K: knit

P: purl

Work:

Cast on 44 stitches.

Knit 5 rows of garter stitch, with a selvedge stitche at the beginning of each row.

Then:

Rows 1-3-5 and 7 (Wrong Side): 1 selvedge stitche, K1, P1, *K2, P1 *, repeat from * to * finish with K2.

Rows 2 and 6 (right side): 1 selvedge stitche, K2, * P2, K1 * repeat from * to* finish with K2.

Row 4 (right side): 1 selvedge stitche, K1,* Twist, P2* repeat from * to* finish with K2.

Row 8 (right side): 1 selvedge stitche, K2, * P2, Twist repeat from * to*, finish with P2, K3.

Repeat these 8 rows and finish the scarf with 5 rows of garter stitch, bind off, fasten off.
