## Shawt < Soleil d'Hiver»

Take the wool which you please and knit the according to the manufacturer's instructions, youll get a piece very personal and adapted to your taste: enjoy!

Same: I give indicative number of repetitions of each pattern, you can safely edit them but ensuring however to respect the proportions: ex 4 times increases, 7 times the right part, 4 times decreases(shortest shawt); or even. 6 times increases, 11 times the right part, 6 times decreases(long shawl).

## Abbreviations and points:



M: Marker
sl: Slip 1 stitch knitwise
st. stitch
p:Purl
k: knit
mI: make one
[...]: lace part
(...) x....: knit the stitches between (...) as many times as indicate after x... .

SKP: Slip, Knit, Pass Over

Yo: Yarn Over

K2tog: knit 2 together
Stocking stitch, garter stitch.

## Increase section.

Cast on 13 stitches. Knit 4 rows of garter stitch. : For the first one: $k 5, M, k 1, M, k 7$. And after the first four rows.

Row 1: (right side): (kI, 21 ) $\times 2, k 1, M, K n i t$ all the stitches and before the marker, $m 1, M,[k 3,1 Y \sigma, 1 S K P, 1 Y \sigma, k 2]$.

Row 2:( wrong side) [sl1, $p 5, k 2], M$, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M$, ( $k 1, p 1) \times 2, k 1$.

Row 3: (kI, 21 ) x2, kI, $M$, knit all the stitches between the markers, $M,[k 4,1 Y 0$, ISKP, IYo, k2]

Row 4: $[s l 1, p 6, k 2], M$, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, p 1) \times 2, k 1$.
Row 5: (kI, 21 ) x2, $k 1, M$, Knit all the stitches and before the marker, $m 1, M,[k 5$, IYo, ISKP, IYo, k2]

Row 6: [sl1, p7, k2], M, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, p 1) \times 2, k 1$.
Row 7: (kI, 21 ) $\times 2, k 1, M$, Knit all the stitches and before the marker, $m 1, M,[k 6$, IYo, ISKP, IYo, k2]

Row 8: [sl1, p8, k2], $M$, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, p 1) \times 2, k 1$.
Row 9: (kI, 21 ) x2, $k 1, M$, Knit all the stitches and before the marker, $m 1, M,[k 7$, IYo, ISKP, IYo, k2]

Row 10: [sl1, p9, k2], $M$, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, p 1) \times 2, k 1$. Row 11: $(k 1, p 1) \times 2, k 1, M, k X, M,[k 8,1 Y \sigma, 1 S K P, 1 Y \sigma, k 2]$

Row 12: [sl1, p10, k2], M, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, p 1) \times 2$, kI.

Row 13: (kI, pI) x2, $k 1,>, M, K n i t$ all the stitches and before the marker, $m 1, M,[k 9$, IYo, ISKP, IYo,k2]

Row 14: [sl1, p11, k2], $M$, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, p 1) \times 2$, kI.

Row 15: (k1, PI) x2, K1, M, Knit all the stitches and before the marker, $m 1, M,[10 K$, 1YO, ISKP, 1YO, 2K]

Row 16: [bind off 8st in purling them, p4, k2], M, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, p 1) \times 2, k 1$.

Reproduce 5 times this pattern and move to the Straight section of the shawl.

## Straight section:

Row 1: (right side): $(k I, P 1) \times 2, k 1, M, k n i t$ all the stitches between the markers, $M$, [k3, 1 Yo, 1SKP, $\left.1 Y_{\sigma}, k 2\right]$.

Row 2: (wrong side) [sl1, $25, k 2$ ], $M$, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M$, ( $k 1, p 1) \times 2, k 1$.

Row 3: (kI, PI) x2, kI, M, knit all the stitches between the markers, $M,[k 4,1 Y 0$, ISKP, IYo, k2]

Row 4: [sl1, $16, k 2], M$, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, k 1) \times 2, k 1$.
Row 5: (kI, 1 I) x2, kI, $M$, knit all the stitches between the markers, $M,[k 5,1 Y \sigma$, ISKP, IYo, k2]

Row 6: [Sl1, $27, k 2], M$, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, p 1) \times 2, k 1$. Row 7: (kI, 1 I) $\times 2, k 1, M$, knit all the stitches between the markers, $M,[k 6,1 Y \sigma$, ISKP, IYo, k2]

Row 8: [sl1, p8, k2], $M$, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, p 1) \times 2, k 1$.
Row 9: (kI, 12 ) $x 2, k 1, M$, knit all the stitches between the markers, $M,[k], 1 Y \sigma$, ISKP, IYo, k2]

Row 10: [sl1, p9, k2], M, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, k 1) \times 2, k 1$.
Row 11: (kI, 1 I) x2, kI, $M$, knit all the stitches between the markers, $M,[k 8,1 Y 0$, ISKP, IYo, k2]

Row 12: $[s l 1, p 10, k 2], M$, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, p 1) \times 2$, kI.

Row 13: ( $k 1, R 1$ ) x2, $k 1, \gg, M$, knit all the stitches between the markers, $M,[k 9,1 Y \sigma$, ISKP, IYo, k2]

Row 14: [sl1, $p 11, k 2], M$, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, p 1) \times 2$, kI.

Row 15: (kI, PI) x2, kI, M, knit all the stitches between the markers, M, [10K, 1Y0, 1SKP, 1YO, 2K]

Row 16: [bind off 8st in purling them, p4, k2], M, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k I, R I) \times 2, k 1$.

Reproduce 9 times this pattern and move to the decrease section of the shawt.

## Decrease section:

Row 1: (right side): (kI, R1) $\times 2, k 1, M$, knit the stitches between the markers and when you have 2 stitches left before the marker: K2tog, $M,[k 3,1$ Yo, 1SKP, 1Yo, k2].
Row 2: (wrong side) [sl1, $p 5, k 2], M$, purl all the stitches between the markers , $M,($ $k 1, R 1) \times 2, k I$.

Row 3: (KI, P1) x2, kI, M, knit all the stitches between the markers, $M,[k 4, I Y O$, ISKP, IY $\sigma, k 2]$

Row 4: $[s 11, p 6, k 2], M$, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, p 1) \times 2, k 1$.
Row 5: (kI, 1 I) $\times 2, k 1, M$, knit the stitches between the markers and when you have 2 stitches left before the marker: K 2 tog, $M,\left[k 5,1 Y_{\sigma}, 1 S K P, 1 Y_{\sigma}, k 2\right]$

Row 6: [Sl1, $27, k 2], M$, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, p 1) \times 2, k 1$.
Row 7: (kI, RI) x2, kI, M, knit the stitches between the markers and when you have 2 stitches left before the marker: K2tog, $M,\left[k 6, I Y_{\sigma}, 1 S K P, I Y_{\sigma}, k 2\right]$

Row 8: [sl1, $28, k 2], M$, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, k 1) \times 2, k 1$.

Row 9: (kI, RI) xI, kI, M, knit the stitches between the markers and when you have 2 stitches left before the marker: K2tog, $M,\left[k 7, I Y_{\sigma}, I S K P, I Y_{\sigma}, k 2\right]$

Row 10: [sly, pa, k2], M, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, p 1) \times 2, k 1$.
Row 11: ( $k$ I , P1) x2, kI, $M$, knit all the stitches between the markers, $M$,
[ $k 8,1 Y_{\sigma, 1 S K P, 1 Y \sigma, k 2]}$
Row 12: $[s l 1, p 10, k 2], M$, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, p 1) \times 2$, kI.

Row 13: ( $k 1, p 1$ ) x2, $k 1,>, M$, knit the stitches between the markers and when you have 2 stitches left before the marker: K2tog, $M,\left[k 9, I Y_{0}, I S K P, I Y_{0}, k 2\right]$

Row 14: $[s l 1, p 11, k 2], M$, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, p 1) \times 2$, kI.

Row 15: ( $k 1, ~ P 1$ ) $\times 2, k 1, M$, knit the stitches between the markers and when you have 2 stitches left before the marker: K2 tog, $\mathrm{M},[10 \mathrm{~K}, 1 \mathrm{YO}, 1 \mathrm{KKP}, 1 \mathrm{YO}, 2 \mathrm{~K}]$
Row 16: [bind off st in purling them, p4, k2], M, purl all the stitches between the markers, $M,(k 1, R 1) \times 2, k 1$.

Reproduce 5 times this pattern.
After the 16 th row of the last pattern. make 4 rows of garter stitch with the 13 remaining stitches and cast off, block the shawl, fasten off. Wear... offer... and make another!
