## IDAGETTV SQUARE BASKET DATTERN


«Lattice-work effect » Stitch : crochet a series of [single crochet $(X)+$ chain ( $O$ )] in each hole made by chains of previous row. $\mathrm{O}=$ beginning


You need half-ball of Hooked Zpagetti
Tool : crochet $n^{\circ} 10$ or 12
Size of basket : $21 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21 \mathrm{~cm} \times 9 \mathrm{~cm}$

- Use «lattice-work effect » stitch to do a square of $21 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21 \mathrm{~cm}$, i.e. 17 stitches $\times 16$ rows.
- Continue by crocheting all around the square, always using « lattice-work effect » stitch, i.e. single crochet in the seven holes of each side and one in each corner + chain between single crochet. Mark the beginning of round to finish with a slip stitch at the end.
- Turn always in same direction. Do 3 rounds of single crochet. Miss one stitch in each corner. So you'll have 15 then 14 then 13 stitches by side. End each round with a slip stitch.
- Do another round without decreasing, i.e. $4 \times 13$ stitches.
- Next round, continue to do single crochet, but in two opposite sides, replace by 5 chain in the middle for handles.
- Last round, single crochet in each stitch and 6 single crochet in handles.
