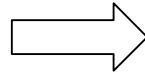


## Verbs in Simple Present Tense

### Affirmative form

I work  
You work  
**He works**  
**She works**  
**It works**  
  
We work  
You work  
They work



### Examples :

1. I **go** to school on Monday.
2. You **work** in a bank.
3. Carla **makes** delicious cakes.
4. Mr Johnson **teaches** English.
5. Susan **studies** in Oxford school.
6. Bob **revises** his lessons everyday.
7. Bobby **eats** his food quickly.
8. The boys **listen** to music.
9. Sanae and Sarah **watch** TV.
10. My dog **barks** a lot.

Remark : To work (verb + **s**) \_\_\_\_\_ S/he/it works  
To watch (verb + **es**) \_\_\_\_\_ S/he/it watches  
To study (verb + **ies**) \_\_\_\_\_ S/he/it studies

## Possessive adjectives

### Examples :

1. I'm Jack. **My** family name is Wilson.
2. This is my sister. **Her** name is Olivia.
3. He is my cousin. **His** name is Omar.
4. It is my dog. **Its** name is Bobby.
5. What's **your** name ?
6. These are students. **Their** father is a policeman.
7. Mohammed the 6th is **our** king.

### Remark :

- ⇒ Subject pronoun + verb \_\_\_\_\_ **I** live in Tangier  
⇒ Possessive adjective + noun \_\_\_\_\_ **My** name is Bob.
