

Sweet Shawl

Size of the shawl : 63/150cm

Materiall :

[4 balls of Odin Viking of Norway](#)

Circular needles 6.5mm and a long cable.

6 stitch marker

420 beads

A fine hook (1mm)

Points and abbreviations :

k: knit

p: purl

Yo : yarn over

m1r : make one right

m1l : make 1 left

SK2P: slip the first stitch knitwise, knit the 2 following stitches together and pass the slip stitch over. [you can have a look there is necessary.](#)

M: stitch marker

R : row

...: knit the motive between *...* as many time as necessary.

You can insert beads in the lace part of the shawl, in the wrong side rows, insert the beads on the yarn over of the previous row with the hook. ([see there for help](#))



Body of the shawl :

Note : the increases of the body of the shawl are made with yarn ove, if you prefer you can make 1 instead of a yarn over.

Cast on 21 stitches

R1: k2, Yo, k3, Yo, M, k1, M, Yo, k4, Yo, M, k1, M, Yo, k4, Yo, M, k1, M, Yo, k3, Yo, k2.

R2 : k2, purl all the following stitches and finish the row in knitting the 2 last stitches.

R3: k2, Yo, k5, Yo, M, k1, M, Yo, k6, Yo, M, k1, M, Yo, k6, Yo, M, k1, M, Yo, k5, Yo, k2.

R4: k2, purl all the following stitches and finish the row in knitting the 2 last stitches.

R5 : k2, Yo, knit all the stitches to the next stitch marker, make a yarn over before this stitch marker, M, k1, M, Yo, knit all the stitches to the next stitch marker, make a yarn over before this stitch marker , M, k1, M, Yo, knit all the stitches to the next stitch marker, make a yarn over before this stitch marker, M, k1, M, Yo, knit all the following stitches and finish the row making 1 Yo and in knitting the 2 last stitches.

R6: k2, purl all the following stitches and finish the row in knitting the 2 last stitches.

Knit the body part by repeating the rows 5 and 6 up to row 55 inclusive.

Lace part :

R 56, 58 and 60: knit all the stitches

R 57 and 59: k2, Yo, knit all the stitches to the next stitch marker, Yo, M, k1, M, Yo, knit all the stitches to the next stitch marker, Yo, M, k1, M, Yo, knit all the stitches to the next stitch marker, Yo, M, k1, M, Yo, knit all the following stitches and finish the row making 1 Yo and in knitting the 2 last stitches.

R 61: k2, Yo, k3, *Yo, k4, SK2P, k4, Yo, k1*, finish with k2, Yo, k2.

R 62 and all the wrong side rows (unless otherwise stated) : k2, purl all the following stitches and finish the row in knitting the 2 last stitches. If you want to insert beads, made on the yarn over of the previous row, except the first and last of the row.

R 63: k2, Yo, k4, *k1, Yo, k3, SK2P, k3, Yo, k2*, finish with k3, Yo, k2.

R 65: k2, Yo, k5, *k2, Yo, k2, SK2P, k2, Yo, k3*, finish with k4, Yo, k2.

R 67: k2, Yo, k6, *k3, Yo, k1, SK2P, k1, Yo, k4*, finish with k5, Yo, k2.

R 69: k2, Yo, k7, *k4, Yo, SK2P, Yo, k5*, finish with k6, Yo, k2.

R 71: k2, Yo, k8, *k1, m1r, k10, m1l, k1* finish with k7, Yo, k2.

R 72: knit all the stitches.

R 73: k2, Yo, k9, *Yo, k5, SK2P, k5, Yo, k1*, finish with k8, Yo, k2.

R 75: k2, Yo, k10, *k1, Yo, k4, SK2P, k4, Yo, k2*, finish with k9, Yo, k2.

R 77: k2, Yo, k11, *k2, Yo, k3, SK2P, k3, Yo, k3*, finish with k10, Yo, k2.

R 79: k2, Yo, k12, *k3, Yo, k2, SK2P, k2, Yo, k4*, finish with k11, Yo, k2.

R 81: k2, Yo, k13, *k4, Yo, k1, SK2P, k1, Yo, k5*, finish with k12, Yo, k2.

R 83: k2, Yo, k14, *k5, Yo, SK2P, Yo, k6*, finish with k13, Yo, k2.

Final edge , biding off and blocking the shawl :

Knit 6 rows, then make 2 rows cast off very loosely knitting:

Right side row : k2, put them back on the left needle and knit them together. Knit the 2 following stitches, put them back on the left needle and knit them together. Do so until the end of the row.

Rang envers : p2, put them back on the left needle and purl them together. Purl the next stitch and put the 2 stitches of the right needle on the left needle, purl them together. Proceed the same way for all stitches.

Wash your shawl. For blocking (it is imperative for the shaping of this shawl), use a crescent shaped, it will be positioned well to knit on the shoulders once worn. Feel free to leave the blocking (and drying) several days, he will not move afterwards.

Cut the threads, wear, give, knit again ...!
