

## Guilvinec Scarf



### Material:

8 balls of cotton « [Sunny](#) » Cheval Blanc, 4 "blanches" and 4 "nattier", needles 6mm.

1 cardboard patch and a hook 5mm (or any other size you have, it's helpful for fringes)

### Points used :

Note : This model knits with the thread in double, to do it, I recommend you to make balls grouping directly 2 threads, it is easier to use.

Garter stitch : knit every stitches in every rows.

Fancy point : [Have a look there !](#)

Row 1 (right side): 1 slid stitch, \*knit4, slid2 \*, repeat from\*to\* , knit 5.

Row 2 (wrong side): 1 slid stitch, \* Purl 4, Purl 2 through back of loop\* repeat from \*to\*, finish with purl 4 and knit 1.

Stripes: knit rows 1 and 2 alternately in white and in nattier.

### Work:

Begin by cutting fringes: make 10 fringes of every color, containing each 14 threads, of 70cm of length approximately. Reserve them.

Cast on 42 stitches in color nattier (with the thread in double) ,make 2 rows of garter stitch may begin the fancy point in stripe (2 rows nattier, 2 rows in white). Continue up to 145 cms in height and make a last stripe in white, then 2 rows of garter stitch still in white, bind off on the right side.

Insert fringes, for the nattiers of the highly-rated nattier and for the whites of highly-rated white. Nothing prevents you from modifying these fringes, from mixing them or from alternating them in your mood! Equalize fringes. Bring in the threads, cut them to short ... wear!!!
