Review of the latest film that I saw : The Hobbit and Django Unchained.

Firstly, a storyline of these two films to know a little more about each histories.

The Hobbit :

At the beginning, Bilbo Baggins is simply a hobbit who lives in the Shire but he is swept into a quest to reclaim the lost Dwarf Kingdom of Erebor from the fearsome dragon Smaug. He travels in the Middle Earth along with the wizard Gandalf the Grey and thirteen dwarves. Django :
