Moda Candy:

- 10-2½" x 2½" Dark Blue squares
- 2-2½" x 2½" Light Blue squares
- 8-2½" x 2½" Red squares
- 16-2½" x 2½" Tan squares

Binding :

(¼ yard)
2-2½" x WOF strips

Backing: 1 Fat Quarter 18" x 22"

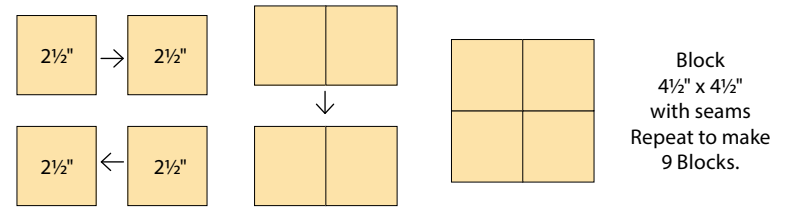
Fusible web

Perle cottons to match wools

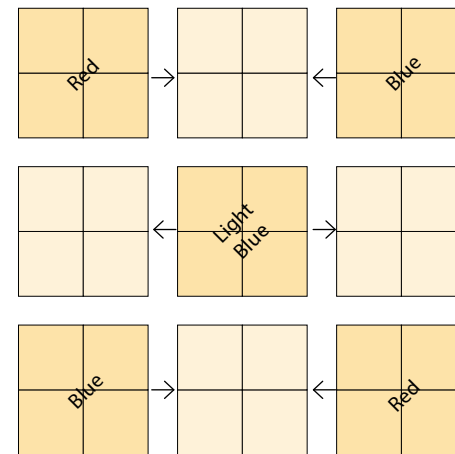
Wool Appliqué: (listed on the template
page 38)

Quilt Construction

- 1 **Block:** Combine 4-2½" squares: 4-sets of tan, 2-sets of red, 2-sets dark blue and 1-set light blue.



- 2 Assemble 3 Blocks to make 1 row. Make 3 rows. *Note the placement of the different color Blocks.* Combine the rows.



- 3 **Appliqué:** Using photo as a guide trace the appropriate number of appliqué shapes* onto fusible web. Cut out fusible web just outside of drawn lines. Place fusible shapes onto correct wools and iron. Cut out on drawn lines. Remove paper and place appliqués onto pieced background. Iron using steam. Blanket-stitch around appliqués using matching threads. Stem stitch the border & stars on the sheep blanket.

**appliqué shapes are on page 38*

- 4 Sew 2-2½" Binding strips together. Layer, quilt and bind. ENJOY!

Templates are reversed.
Seam allowances are not included.

Appliques:

I used wools,
but cottons can be used also:

6" x 6" red wool

4" x 6" blue wool

4" x 8" cream wool

1½" x 3" black wool
