## Scrapbooking Project Sheet

"This scrapbooking is fun, but what else can
I do with a $12 \times 12$ sheet of paper?", you ask. How about a beautiful gift box to fill with some special treats? And you won't believe how easy it is! All you need are $t_{\text {wo }}$ sheets of paper and scissors.


First let's make the top of the box. Find the center of $12 \times 12$ paper and mark it lightly with a pencil on the blank side.

$\int$ Bring two opposing points . to center as in diagram.

2.

Next fold one point of the 2. paper to the center mark and crease crisply. Repeat with remaining three points so that they all meet in the center.


6 Then bring the left and right edges up to create the sides of the box. Tuck the side tabs together to create the remaining sides of the box.


3Now fold the right and left opposing edges into the center and crease the fold line crisply. Unfold the right and left and repeat with the top and bottom edges.


4Unfold the entire configuration until the $12 \times 12$ paper is flat. With scissors make four lateral cuts as shown


7 Finally pull the last two 7. points over the tabs to reinforce these final two sides of the box. Secure with glue stick or tape.


8 To make the bottom of the O. gift box, trim $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ off two sides of the second $12 \times 12$ sheet and proceed with the same seven steps used to create the top of box.
