Arquebuse

Arquebuse is a semi circular shawl. To knit it, I used "Ka-risma" yarn from Drop's wich is a sport yarn, but you can use any kind of yarn: it will just change the shawl's size: take



yarn and needle bigger if you want a bigger shawl and yarn and needle smaller if you want a smaller shawl.

1 used a circular needle size 7US (4,5mm).

Stitches 1 used:

Stockinette stitch: Knit on the right side and purl on the wrong side

Garter stitch: always knit

<u>Fishnet</u>: Row 1 : K1 [1 Yarn over (yo), knit 2 together (K2tog)] through the row

Row 2: purl

Row 3: [K2tog, 1yo] until 1 stitch from the end, end by k1

Row 4: purl

If there is not enough rows to make the entire fishnet pattern, just go to the next stitch

Increase row: [K1, 1y0] through the row, end by K1

Knitting the shawl:

As said earlier, Arquebuse is a semi circular shawl made by stockinette stitch and fishnet stripes split by garter stitch lines made with a different colour. The stockinette stitch and fishnet stripes are larger and larger. To make it easy, I named the two colour "blue" and "pink" but, of course, you can use any colour you want. The shawl ends by a flywheel in blue stockinette and pink garter lines.

Cast on, with a provisional cast on, 3 stitches with the blue yarn, knit 6 garter rows.

Turn your work and knit 3 stiches on the side (1 by garter line) and take back your provisional cast on : you have 9 stiches on your needle.

Row 1 (BLUE): K2, 1 YO, K5, 1YO, K2

Row 2, 3, 4 (Blue): STOCKINETTE STITCH

Row 5 (PINK): INCREASE ROW

Rows 6 to 8 (PINK): GARTER STITCH (3 ROWS)

Rows **9 TO 12** (BLUE): FISHNET (4 ROWS)

Rows 13 & 14 (BLUE): GARTER STITCH

Row 15 (BLUE): INCREASE ROW

Rows 16 TO 22 (Blue): STOCKINETTE STITCH (7 ROWS)

ROW 23 (PINK): INCREASE ROW

Rows 24 TO 26 (PINK): GARTER STITCH (3 ROWS)

Rows **27 TO 32** (BLUE): FISHNET (6 ROWS)

Rows 33 & 34 (PINK): GARTER STITCH

ROW 35 (BLUE): [K2, 1 YO] THROUGH THE ROW, ENDING BY K1

Rows 36 to 44 (Blue): STOCKINETTE STITCH (9 ROWS)

Rows 45 to 48 (PINK): GARTER STITCH (4 ROWS)

Rows **49 TO 56** (BLUE): FISHNET (8 ROWS)

Rows 57 & 58 (PINK): GARTER STITCH

Rows 59 TO 70 (BLUE): STOCKINETTE STITCH (12 ROWS)

Row 71 (PINK): INCREASE ROW

Rows 72 TO 74 (PINK): GARTER STITCH (3 ROWS)

Rows **75 TO 84** (BLUE): FISHNET (10 ROWS)

Rows 85 & 86 (pink): Garter Stitch

Rows 87 to 100 (Blue): Stockinette Stitch (14 Rows)

Rows 101 TO 104 (PINK): GARTER STITCH (4 ROWS)

Rows **105 TO 116** (BLUE): FISHNET (12 ROWS)

Rows 117 & 118 (PINK): GARTER STITCH

Rows 119 TO 134 (BLUE): STOCKINETTE STITCH (16 ROWS)

Rows 135 & 136 (PINK): GARTER STITCH

Row 137 (Blue): Increase row (Beginning of the final flywheel)

Rows 138 TO 140 (BLUE): STOCKINETTE STITCH

Rows 141 & 142 (PINK): GARTER STITCH

Rows 143 to 146 (Blue): STOCKINETTE STITCH (4 ROWS)

Rows 147 & 148 (PINK): GARTER STITCH

Rows 149 TO 152 (Blue): STOCKINETTE STITCH (4 ROWS)

BIND OFF AND BLOCK
